

To the Union Little League families involved with Tee Ball and Single A divisions:

First, I hope you and your families are safe during these difficult times. It's been the hope of our Board of Directors that, at some point, we could resume the game of baseball for these divisions. We have solicited advice from the Union School District, the Santa Clara County Office of Public Health, Little League International, and the nine (9) other leagues who are part of District 12. We have also asked for input from our managers and coaches.

Last night, our board made the decision to **cancel the spring season for Tee Ball and Single A**. This was a very difficult decision, as we view the tee ballers, Single A kids and their families as the "future" of Union Little League. Since October, we had put plans in place to make the introduction to youth sports, or the continuation of your child's baseball career, a great experience. However, because of the mandated Covid-19 protocols for the resumption of practices, the age of these players, and the small number of players who "might" have come back to "practice", we decided it would be in the best interests of all to cancel this season. With that said, our ULL families are always welcome to utilize the field when they are not in use.

Union Little League is a non-profit charitable organization, dedicated to providing a wonderful baseball experience for our local community. All revenue generated goes towards our fields and operations. After an exhaustive analysis of our finances, **we have decided to offer two options to our families:**

1. A \$50 per player refund (paid via check)
- OR**
2. Decline the refund and offer it to the league as a donation
