

To the Union Little League families involved with AA, AAA, and Majors divisions:

First, I hope you and your families are safe during these difficult times. It's been the hope of our Board of Directors that at some point, we could resume the game of baseball for these divisions. We have solicited advice from the Union School District, the Santa Clara County office of Public Health, Little League International, and the nine other leagues who are part of District 12. We have also asked for input from our managers and coaches. 2 leagues have elected to "cancel" baseball for this spring, with no refunds.

On Thursday night, June 11, our board made the decision **to open up practices for AA, AAA, and Majors**. Most of our managers felt that the majority of players in these divisions would be excited to return to baseball practices. Attached, please find a **waiver which will need to be signed and returned to your team's manager before starting activities**, and our C-19 protocols which are required to be followed per the county of Santa Clara.

Union Little League is a non-profit charitable organization, dedicated to providing a wonderful baseball experience for our local community. All revenue generated goes towards our fields and operations. We hope you elect to join your teammates, beginning June 20. If not, and after an exhaustive analysis of our finances, **we have decided to offer two options to our families:**

1. A \$50 per player refund (paid via check) **OR**
2. Decline the refund and offer it to the league as a donation

Note: Snack shack tickets will be valid for the next Spring Season.
