Hello Union Little League families,

It is fall of 2021 and we are at the end of our fall baseball season. Fall ball is a great opportunity for players to get more playing time in a more relaxed baseball environment. In general, players will play in their normal division or play up a division if they want to test the waters. Games are played with other little leagues in the area and the score isn't kept. This is about getting the kids on the field for one game per week and one practice per week knowing there are other fall sports/activities that need to be juggled. The league calendar has information for this weekend's event and other key dates will be posted.

This Saturday, November 6 we have a full day of baseball from 9AM to - 2PM. Our ULL AAA fall ball teams play at 9AM on the AAA field, ULL AA teams face off at noon on the AAA field, and ULL Majors fall ball teams play at noon on the Majors field. The snack shack will be open with a very minimal menu (Burgers & Dogs) from 11-3. Please come out and watch to cheer on the Union Little League Majors, AAA, and AA fall ball teams. This is a great opportunity to come out and see many families and introduce new families to the league and help to grow our local league.

We are also gearing up to start registration for our spring baseball season. Registration will start mid November, followed by address verification night in December, evaluation day in early January, and first practices starting in February. The season will officially kick off in early March 2022 with Opening Day and our first games. Visit the ULL website for the latest information.

Union Little League elected a new Board of Directors this past month. All ULL families were invited to participate in our Annual General Meeting held at the end of September. During this meeting, we reviewed the state of Union Little League and discussed who would like to join the Board of Directors. Those interested volunteers met again in mid-October to elect our officers and to start the planning for the 2022 season. Our new board members are listed out by position on the ULL website. Recent Division Changes

The ULL Board recently voted to streamline all divisions. In order to keep games fun and interesting, many leagues have gone to 4 divisions. We will have the following four divisions: Majors (Ages 10,11,12), Minors (Ages 8,9,10), Farm (Ages 6,7,8), and Tball (Ages 4,5,6). This restructuring allows the most flexibility for players to play at the appropriate level, depending on their skill level. For example, more advanced 8-year olds can try out for Minors, whereas, beginner 8-year olds can opt to play in the Farm Division. This change will also maximize the number of teams in each division providing more teams to compete against throughout the season.

Who is Union Little League?

Union Little League is a non-profit, volunteer run organization that provides an opportunity for all boys and girls to play baseball if their birthday is after September 1, 2009 for the 2022 season and they live in the Union School District. The official Little League age calendar is here. The Board of Directors consists of parents and supporters of the little league that volunteer for positions to run the organization. The board positions include President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Player Agent, Coaching Coordinator, Volunteer Coordinator, Chief of Umpires, Scheduler, Facility Operations, Equipment Manager, Uniform Coordinator, Snack Shack, Fundraising, etc. It truly takes an entire community to run the organization and requires way more than the 15 people on the ULL board of directors. That is where the league needs help from parents to spread the word to have kids play in the league, help to run the operations such as managing, coaching, team coordination, umpiring, fund raising, website management, snack shack, and maintaining the facility to help keep the facility looking great by maintaining the fields, sprinklers, paint, weeds, grass, and general upkeep. It is called Union Little League as any resident living in the Union School District can participate to play in the league, but the district itself is not affiliated directly with the league. ULL leases the playing fields and practice fields from the district and we maintain the grounds ourselves as volunteers or with league funds. We greatly appreciate the support from our community to volunteer time and to help fundraise to cover these costs and keep the league looking and working great.
